# President's Report for year ending 30 November 2011

The activities of our Art Society during the past twelve months were as follows:

Our previous AGM was held on Monday, 13th December 2010 in the Cristina Lounge (Club Marconi) which was followed by our End of Year Function which included a most entertaining Trivia Quiz (composed, orchestrated, conducted and reviewed) by **Peter Markwick**, and other artistic "presentations" and festivities. **Cheryl Tate** won the honour of keeping our "*Good-Ship Arts-Alive Travelling Trophy*" for the duration of 2011.

Beginning Monday 31<sup>st</sup> January we held <u>10 Monthly Meetings</u> (second Monday each Month). Most of these were open management-committee meetings.

The April meeting was a Print Workshop organised by Nika Norman.

The July meeting featured **Ron Stitzinger** with another Creative Workshop titled "Art In An Hour".

For our August meeting Peter Markwick gave us a Conte Crayon Demonstration.

In addition to the Monthly Meetings, micelf(JJ), Joe Briffa, and Lorraine Maggs, attend a number of informal meetings amongst ourselves, and also meetings with representatives of the Fairfield City Museum&Gallery, and the Marconi Board of Directors and Club management. Some notable examples:

In Jan/Feb/March, we, along with many other members, attended several meetings and Protest Demonstrations at the FM&G and Council Chambers. Despite all our arguments, letters, phone calls, emails, petitions, protests and demonstrations, Fairfield Council has got its Cost Cutting measure of eliminating the Full-time FM&G Director position.

As a concession there is now a *Part-time FM&G Co-ordinator* position, filled since September, by Carmel Aiello.

**Joe Briffa**, as our representative, regularly attends monthly meetings of the <u>Club Marconi Sports</u> & <u>Cultural Associations</u>, which are chaired by **Mr. Mario Soligo**, Club Marconi Vice President and Sports President. **Joe** also regularly prepares and submits our "Marconi Art" articles in the "Marconi News" magazine.

In regard to the above, on Sunday  $21^{st}$  March, Nika & Lorraine, Joe & JJ, Ron & Leane and Fawaz Trad, supervised three tables and display screens for Childrens Drawing/Painting activities, for the afternoon of the <u>Club Marconi Sports Carnivale</u>. Good fun was had by all on a warm sunshiny sausage-sizzle sort of day, which included face-painting for the children.

In August, **Joe Briffa**, attended the <u>Fairfield CDSE Funding Presentation/Ceremony</u> at Club Marconi, meeting with Club, and other Volunteer Organisation representatives – Club Marconi yearly sponsors the \$5000 prize money awarded at our Fairfield Art Prize Exhibition.

Every Monday night, outside school holidays, **Nika Norman** has organised <u>Art Classes</u> in the Bocce area, Club Marconi. These classes are for adults and children to expand artistic abilities.

This year **Joe** and **JJ** produced **FOUR "<u>Arts Alive" Newsletters</u>**. Covering Jan 11 to Jan 2012, these were issue numbers **52** to **55** inclusive. Besides <u>three</u> Folding & Stuffing Meeting, Joe & JJ as Co-Editors, had <u>numerous</u> Editorial Meetings in preparing the newsletter for publishing. Under our continuing arrangement with the Club Marconi, the Club now prints, *sometimes* folds, and posts our newsletters for us.

Now, to what we are really about -

This year we successfully organised and managed **FIVE Major Exhibitions.** They were :

• FCAS Member's Prize Exhibition (the 44<sup>th</sup> "Annual Exhibition"), at Club Marconi, was officially opened on Friday 10<sup>th</sup> June, by **Delfina Pipitone** (Club Board Directors). Exhibition was open to the public from 6<sup>th</sup> – 19<sup>th</sup> June. The exhibition was expertly judged by **Gary Carsley** (Senior Lecturer, Hons Co-ord, COFA,UNSW), and **Dr Maryanne Coutts** (Subject Leader, National Art School.

<u>Major prize winners</u> were **John Rice**(Trad), **Matthew Boyle** (Cont), and **J J Supe** (W on P). The winner of the annual \$2000 <u>Club Marconi</u> "<u>Italian Themed</u>" <u>Acquisitive-Prize</u> was **Filomena Vanzanella** with her "*High Perception*". Many thanks to **Club Marconi** for sponsoring this ongoing *feature* addition to our yearly exhibition program. *Bravo* 



- "<u>Impressions Glenda Carter</u>" This year's <u>FM&G Directors Choice Exhibition</u>, of **Glenda's** paintings was opened by **Lorraine Maggs** on 16<sup>th</sup> July and was open to the public 8<sup>th</sup> July, till 14<sup>th</sup> August.
- The <u>Fairfield Art Prize</u> our "<u>19th Annual FAP Exhibition</u>", was Opened by <u>Mario Soligo</u> (Club V-P) and **Delfina Pipitone** (Club Director), on Friday 28<sup>th</sup> Oct (Open to public Oct 24<sup>th</sup>— 6t<sup>h</sup> Nov).

The <u>exhibition judges</u> were **Ms Kim Spooner** (Lecturer Drawing+Painting, **N**ational **Art S**chool), and **Ms Rebecca Beardmore** (Subject Chair- Print Media, Sydney College of **Arts**, Sydney Uni).

Major Prize winners were Helga Kelly (Trad), Peter Markwick (Cont) and J J Supe (W On P).

The <u>Fairfield City M&G Directors Adult Award</u> and the <u>Fairfield City M&G Directors Youth Scholarship Award</u> were not awarded due to cultural cost cuts and Council myopia. 

### Vice President's Report 2011

The year started with protest. The future of our Fairfield Museum & Gallery was under the serious threat of having no professional director or curator. The council had ideas that the establishment could be run on a volunteer basis, hiring out facilities to local groups etc. Fortunately a middle course is now in operation since July through to September with the museum and gallery having been appointed two permanent part-time professionals; the director's job has been down sized to a four day Museum Coordinator and Education Officer and the Curator for Social History is now on site for three days a week.

Before the museum and gallery's previous director, Cedric Boudjema, left in January 2011, Fairfield Art Society members were involved in:-

\*A National Costume Workshop which took place over four Saturdays in January. Our design team included Lorraine Maggs – Coordinator of workshop; Sadhana Peterson -Textile & mixed media artist who made and created materials for the costume; Susan Grant – Aboriginal artist; and Art Society team members, Charlie Wells, Shen Wednesday, Cheryl Tate and Peter Markwick.

The project was to design an Australian National costume to be displayed along with Danny Huynh's, *Portraits of Fairfield – Pride and Passion* which included 50 communities wearing their traditional costume in front of their houses. The show was curated by Helen Tierney. Textile workshops invited different nationalities to share their techniques. The exhibition ran from 18 March to 15 May. 2011.

\* Loop, open Saturday, 20 August- 8 October 2011.

Carmel Aiello – Museum Coordinator and Education Officer wrote in the foreword of the *Loop* catalogue:-

"The bodies of work in Loop reflect often personal views about the world (whether physical or metaphysical), as a place of interaction, imagination, and contemplation. Ideas about spirituality, stereotypes, identity and place are explored through diverse artistic mediums and styles, personal experiences and associations. Whether the works are critical, evocative, poetic, or fun, it's their ability to connect to the viewers' experiences and associations, which loop us back into the artist's world."

\*Synergy, coordinated by Di Hallinan and Lorraine Maggs is a project which involves the synergy of the different artistic practices and ideas of the six participating artists. Artists besides the coordinators include Linda Brescia, Pamela Rodoreda, John Supe and Charlie Wells. This exhibition will take place in the Marsden Gallery, Casula Powerhouse Art Centre from Friday, 23 March to Sunday 20 May 2012.

\*"I want to know what love is"...songs of love, memories and personal stories is a collaborative project between Casula Powerhouse arts Centre and artist Joanne Saad, 23 March to Sunday 20 May 2012. The project is seeking people from Western Sydney interested in developing and examining their love of song. Linda Brescia, Shen Wednesday and Lorraine Maggs are currently involved. All members are welcome.

Our Fairfield City Art Society has had a Community representative with the Fairfield City Council Arts Advisory Committee from its first meeting on18 April 2002. Starting with Lorraine Maggs in 2002 other society members on the committee include Linda Brescia and David Capra from c. 2006/7to 2009. Since then David has left the committee leaving Linda Brescia and new committee member Julio Pena as our present representatives in 2011.

# **SYNERGY**

In January 2011 six artists each created a drawn image of their own choosing. The artists then sent a copy of their image to one of the other six so that each artist received a different image. They then used the image they received, in some way, in the production of a second image. The concept of deliberately selecting ideas from someone else meant that the artists then had to push their work in new directions.

So began a creative collaboration that lasted for one year. Every month, using a round robin process, each artist would pass on and receive new work from different artists. From the image passed on to them artists selected influences which appeared in their next work. After eleven months each artist had created eleven works.

It is the resulting 66 works of this creative journey which are on display, showing the influences and contributions of each individual artist as well as the powerful synergy of the combined works.
